2019 NBHA Youth World Rules

Draw #'s and Stall assignments are on the back of this sheet.

1. No Refunds. (Exception vet out rule 12 below)
2. NBHA dress code and hat /helmet rule will be enforced. Holding pen dress code enforced.
3. A maximum of three gate calls will be given after which time a participant will be disqualified.
4. Any participant who competes out of turn will be disqualified.
5. An electronic timer and back up will be used for all rides. Should the timer and back up not function, a rerun will be granted immediately after the event is complete for the day and after a drag or at the Show Manager's discretion.
6. There will be no reruns given if a horse falls.
7. Knocking over a barrel will result in a no time.
8. No signs, banners, or posters shall be displayed, and no business shall be conducted, without prior approval of the Show Manager.
9. A horse and rider combination may not change draw position under any circumstances. (Exception: Administrative error)
10. No rider substitutions.
11. Horse substitutions must be received in the show office before you compete.
12. Any vet out must be received in writing at the NBHA show office no later than Noon EST, July 9. NBHA will retain stall fees if applicable. 70 percent of the entry fees paid will be returned to the entrant.
13. Payout will be 70 percent of the entry fees to the jackpot. Added money will be pro rated per class, then split evenly per division.
14. Prizes will be awarded after all competition is completed for the entire show. If you are not present to accept your award, the NBHA cannot guarantee that you will receive your prizes.
15. A horse may only run once per class, exception Section A, Rule 12 of the NBHA Rule Book.
16. Any questions or disputes that may arise during the show will be settled by the Show Manager, whose decision will be final.
17. Number to the finals- # of Finalists Teen - 200 Youth - 150
18. Payout will be 25 percent to each Go Round and 50 percent to the Finals.
19. Participants may not change horses during an event.
20. Each participant will be given the opportunity to ride in two Go Rounds. The top 15 Youth and top 20 Teen horse and rider teams per division, per Go Round, will advance to the finals. In the Second Go Round we will bump past those already qualified. Unfilled slots will not be pulled from the 1st Go. Riding once is an option. The finals will be a clean slate 5D barrel race. You may place in any division in the finals regardless of what division you qualified in.
21. All qualified horses may advance to the finals.
22. Participants must display saddle numbers on the left leg side of their saddle pad/blanket during competition and must wear armbands at all times.
23. Failure to check in with gate officials makes you subject to disqualification. It is each contestant's responsibility to be in the holding pen and ready to run when their name is called.
24. NBHA officials have the right to disqualify any uncontrolled horse which does not begin its performance within three minutes of the time the rider has been called. This rule does not apply to competitors who have not checked in with gate personnel.
25. In the event of a tie for the Championship of any division, the tie breaker rule will apply.
